




Segregation and Disposal of Rubbish

Save our limited resources! Segregate rubbish properly before disposing

3 rules of rubbish disposal

1. Place rubbish out by 8:00 am on specified day
2. Place rubbish in specified place
3. Place segregated rubbish in clear plastic bags before disposing (old papers must be tied with string or placed in a paper bag)

Burnable Rubbish	Clear plastic bag	Food scraps, cooking oil drained into cloth or paper, paper, tissues, scrap material, cloths, leaves, tree branches, disposable nappies, soft toys, etc. Plastic items: cassette tapes, plastic basins, toys, etc. Leather items: shoes, bags, etc. Rubber items: rubber hose pipes, etc.	Monday & Thursday	Tuesday & Friday	* Drain water from food scraps. * Remove soiling from disposable nappies. * Drain used cooking oil into cloth or paper.

Cartons lined with aluminium cannot be recycled. Please dispose of those as burnable rubbish 	Every Tuesday	Every Monday	* Do not place rubbish or bind with tape * Waxed or oil lined cardboard should be disposed of as burnable rubbish. * Any plastic from tissue boxes and any leather or plastic covering on magazines should be disposed of as burnable rubbish. * Metal serrated strips from plastic wrap/aluminum foil boxes should be disposed of as non-burnable rubbish . * Paper cartons : Please wash, open and dry paper cartons, then tie them with string and take them out.

Plastic caps should be disposed of with plastic containers. Metal caps should be disposed of as Metal Products. * Empty contents and rinse before disposing.

Large articles of rubbish		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Furniture: shoe boxes, wardrobes, bookshelves, crockery cabinets, sofas, etc. ● Bedding: Futon mattresses, beds, carpets, etc. ● Electrical appliances: Stereos, microwave ovens, etc. ● Other items: Bicycles, 50cc scooters, gas stoves, fuel heaters, laundry racks, poles etc. 	All regions of Kagoshima City Tel: (099) 813-5380		★ You must apply in advance by telephone in order to dispose of these items. * Please purchase a coupon with the value of the specified fee, paste it on the item, and place it out on the specified day. * Remove all fuel or oil from scooters/heaters before disposal.
Pruned branches		Branches leftover from when somebody prunes their garden trees etc. Limited to branches less than 10 cm in diameter and less than 50 cm in length. This includes branches of fruit trees, bamboo, and branches with leaves attached.	All regions of Kagoshima City Tel: (099) 268-8888		★ You must apply in advance by telephone in order to dispose of these items. * On the designated day, please tie them up with a string, or put them in a transparent bag up to 45 litres in size and put them out at the gate etc. You don't need to be present when they are taken away.
Items not collected by Kagoshima City	Kagoshima City is unable to dispose of the following items. Please contact the place of purchase, or a specialised rubbish disposal company for collection. TVs, air-conditioners, washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, computers marked 'recyclable', pianos, iron poles (longer than 2 metres), large water heaters, agricultural equipment, bricks, sand, soil, tyres, fire extinguishers, car batteries, concrete slabs, tiles, gas cylinders, waste oil, kerosene, paint, explosives, pesticides, etc.
